Nunney is a village 20 miles south of Bath, near Frome on the edge of the Mendip Hills in Somerset. Mentioned in Domesday Book, Nunney has a history that goes back to Roman, Saxon and medieval times.

Today, the tourist attractions are the ruins of the French-style, moated Nunney Castle (1373), an historic church, country inn, tea


the river. The village hall hosts the
